CWI's Key Achievements

CWI puts focus and engages communities in three (3) areas of ministry interventions;

1. Training
2. Evangelism
3. Community Development



Training

CWI reached out to the communities in Uganda through Wise Choices for Life: a training aimed at stimulating positive sexual and family behaviors among youth and young adults. The training seeks to ensure behavioral change from a Christian perspective. It equips participants with skills to help them make wise, sound decisions concerning their sexual, reproductive, and family health toward manageable families. <https://wisechoicesforlife.org>

Trauma Healing: This training helps individuals and communities disentangle from their past hurt and embrace forgiveness and reconciliation to restore holistic relationships.

Our trainers often hold week-long training and ask participants to draw or write about their past hurtful experiences, after which they burn their paper at a symbolic cross to illustrate the release of this burden. <https://traumahealinginstitute.org>

CWI reached out to six communities in 2022 with these trainings, **including** church leaders of Kasese Pentecostal Church, single and teenage mothers at Children's Restoration Outreach, students at Busoga Light College, community and religious leaders in Nsakabusolo, the unreached people group at the IK mountains in Kaabong. We conducted a WCFL "Train the Trainer" session for community development ministries in the Jinja district.

These trainings **directly reached 333 people.**

Evangelism

"Those who are wise will shine like the brightness of the heavens, and those who lead many to righteousness, like the stars forever and ever" – Daniel 12:3.

As a result of your support, **the evangelism team reached out to 1,202 people with the Good News.** The team reached out to neighboring communities around Jinja. They also had the privilege of sharing the gospel with students in High Schools in the Jinja area.

One way to share and show Christ's love is at the local hospitals of Uganda. The patient must have a caregiver to perform personal tasks, including bathing, laundry, and feeding. We can share the gospel by giving food and necessities to encourage the lonely and hungry at the hospitals we visit.

We ended the year with our first soccer tournament, which was an evangelistic outreach. We had ten teams selected from different motorcycle stops to compete against one another. Motorcycles (Boda-boda are the local taxi service and are very common) as many Ugandans don't have cars.

Organizing this tournament allowed us to engage players and their supporters in one-on-one gospel conversations during the games. These gospel conversations resulted in **35 people trusting Jesus as their personal Lord and Savior.**

Community Development

Grace Ministry focuses on the widows, orphans, and the disadvantaged in the local communities.

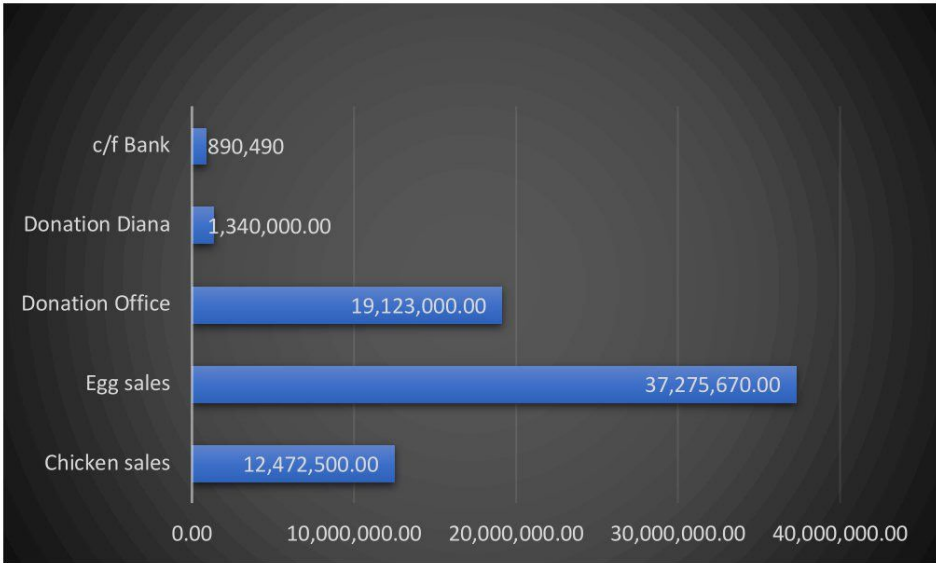
Grace Ministry team directly impacted 123 people in 2022.

In 2022, we opened the vegetable garden, planted three acres of corn, and harvested 650 kgs (1,433 pounds) of corn, which helped feed the layer birds at the poultry farm.

We had over 2,000 layers in stock as well. The business was able to break even, so this endeavor was successful. However, as the year ended, we had to sell the layer birds because feeds were so expensive, we could not maintain or replenish our supply.

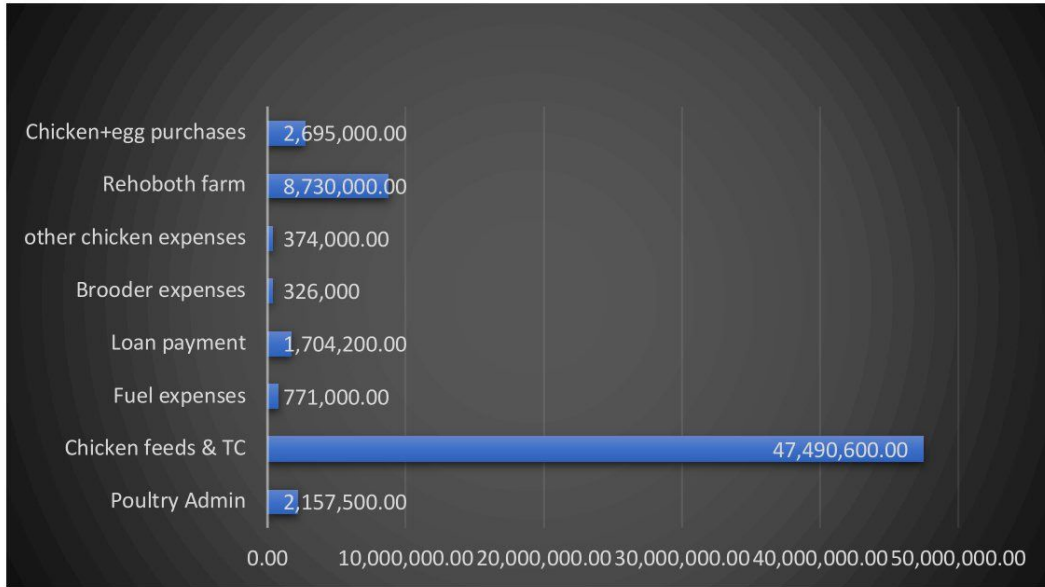
Farm Financial Reports 2022

Farm Sources of Income 2022



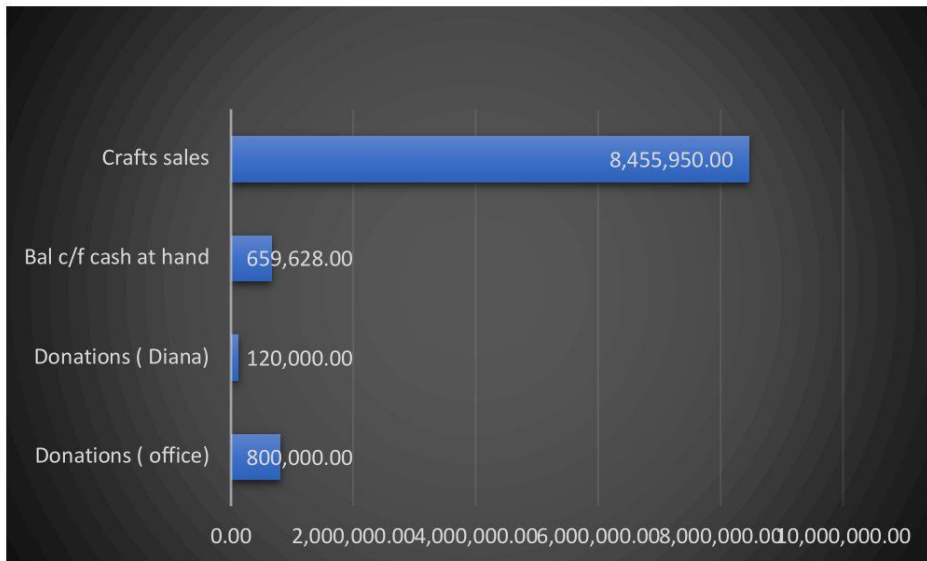

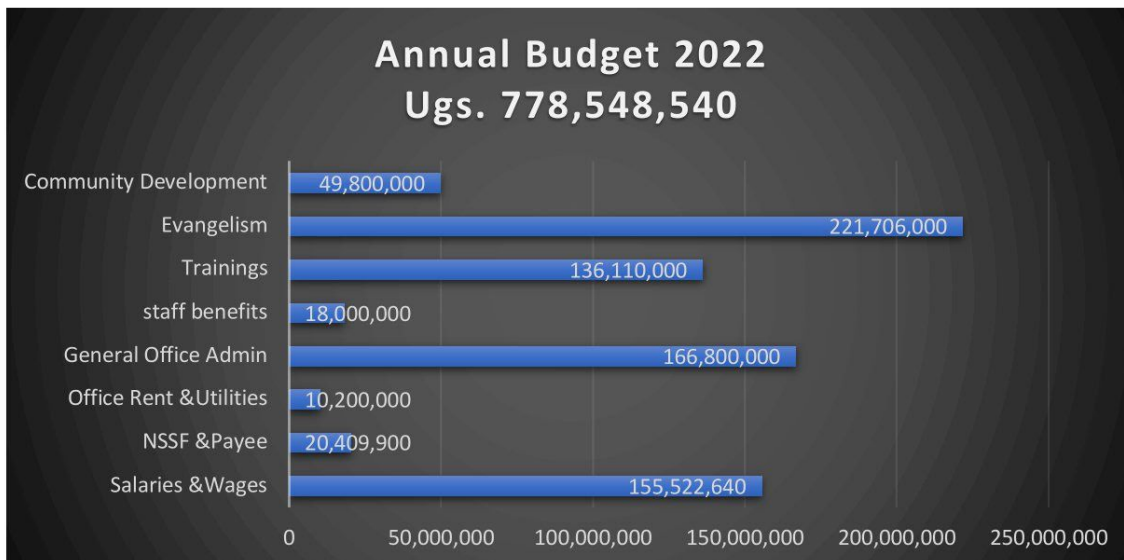
Expenses for Craft Studio

CWI Annual Budget 2022



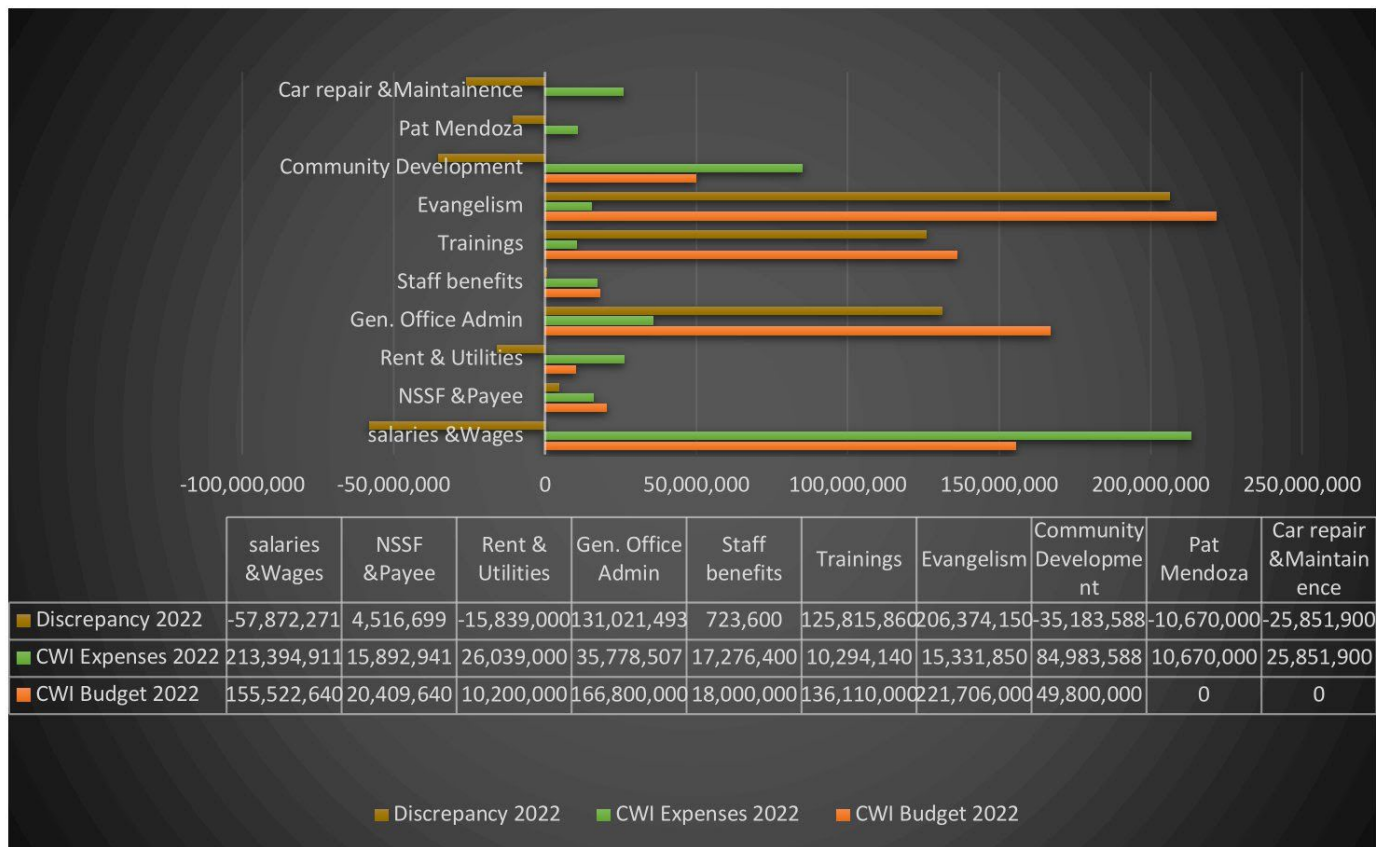

COMPARATIVE ANALYSIS OF CWI BUDGET, EXPENSE, AND DIFFERENCE IN 2022



Please note:

- 1. CWI's Annual budget for 2022 was Ugs. 778,548,540 in US Dollars, \$222,442.**
- 2. CWI's Annual Expenses in 2022 was Ugs.525,084,021 in US Dollars \$150,024.**
- 3. The Difference between the annual budget 2022 and the Annual expenses was Ugs. 253,464,519 in US Dollars, \$72,418.**

* A considerable amount of money spent on community development was for medical bills of two clients that underwent surgeries but was covered by donations.

* A part of our income in 2022 was a donation for the construction of Mt. Sinai Primary School of Ugs: 33,300,000 or \$9,250.

Future Plans

We plan for 2023 in **Sharing and Showing Christ's Love** through Training, Evangelism, and Community Development programs. We have scheduled a new training for our staff to cover the "Helping Without Hurting in Africa" book, student program training, widow's meetings, and evangelism outreaches.
